



U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.27 a gallon on Monday. That's up 7.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.06 a gallon, up 4.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.90 a gallon, up 9.4 cents from a week ago.
