U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$3.43 a gallon on Monday. That's down 8.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.37 a gallon, down 11.6 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.95 a gallon, down 9.4 cents from a week ago.
