



Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 7-tenths of a cent from last week to \$4.03 per gallon. That's down 3.9 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region are at \$4.00 per gallon, down 1.7 cents from last week, but up 3-tenths of a cent from a year ago.
