Terms and Conditions

APPLICATION: This *Form 685A* must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. Trade allies are advised to retain a copy of this application and any accompanying documentation submitted to Energy Trust of Oregon, Inc. under this program. Energy Trust will not be responsible for lost documentation pertaining to this application request. Incentives are available for Early Design Assistance's held between January 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024. Funds for the Incentives are limited and available on a first-come first-served basis. Application must be submitted within 90 days of Early Design Assistance in order to be eligible for incentives.

ELIGIBILITY: Early Design Assistance incentives are available to builders and developers planning housing developments to be sited in the Oregon electric service territories of Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, or the Oregon gas service territories of NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista or the Washington gas service territories of NW Natural. Eligible candidates must be an approved trade ally with the EPS New Construction program.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS: This offer is subject to change and Energy Trust may amend this offer in any way; provided, however, that any such amendment will not affect payment obligations incurred by Energy Trust under this offer for Early Design Assistance funding approved prior to an amendment. Determinations about Early Design Assistance funding eligibility shall be in Energy Trust's sole discretion.

PAYMENT: The Incentives will be promptly paid on (i) submission and approval of the completed Early Design Assistance Application.

(ii) invoice receipt and (ii) W-9. Payments will be made to the Applicant and must match name on W-9, if W-9 is required. Please allow up to 60 days for receipt of payment.

INCENTIVE AMOUNT: Incentive funds are available for any single approved Early Design Assistance event. Oregon builders may complete a maximum of two (2) Early Design Assistance opportunities to a single developer or builder during the offer period. Washington builders may complete a maximum of one (1) Early Design Assistance opportunity to a single developer or builder during the offer period.

RURAL: To qualify for the rural incentive, the housing developments must be sited within Energy Trust Regions 1, 2, 5, 7, 9, 10 or 11, excluding homes within the city limits of Corvallis, Eugene, Springfield, and Hood River. Upon request, program staff can make exceptions to qualify additional areas as rural.

INDEMNIFICATION: Applicant shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Energy Trust and Energy Trust, their directors, officers, employees, subcontractors, and agents (altogether, "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims, demands, suits, losses, or damages, including attorney fees and costs of litigation, which may be incurred by any of the Indemnified Parties in connection with this offer.
