How to Access the UIC DataApplication

The UIC Data Application is located at <u>https://uicdata.epa.gov.</u> Access to the Application is restricted to authorized EPA or UIC primacy program users who have a registered account. This document describes the steps that users should take to establish UIC Data Application accounts and access the Application.

State and tribal users will follow a different process than EPA staff to gain access. The document details the process for each user group in separate sections: "Access for State and Tribal Users" and "Access for EPA Users." EPA staff will also need to assist state and tribal users to gain access, which is described in the section, "Assisting State and Tribal Users with Access."

Access for State and Tribal Users

State and tribal users must have both a Login.gov account as well as an EPA Web Application Access (WAA) account associated with the same email address before they can receive access to the UIC Data Application.

State and tribal users with existing Login.gov and EPA WAA accounts should email <u>uicdatacollection@epa.gov</u> with a request for access to the UIC Data Application.

State and tribal users <u>without</u> an existing Login.gov account should navigate to <u>https://login.gov/create-an-account/</u> to create a Login.gov account.

Once the user has a Login.gov account they need to register for an EPA WAA account. The user should navigate to <u>https://waa.epa.gov</u> and sign in with their Login.gov account information. They will then be taken to the access registration form, as shown in Figure 2. The access registration form asks the state or tribal user to designate an EPA contact as a sponsor for their account, as shown in Figure 2. Users should consult the list of EPA staff in Table 1 to determine the appropriate EPA regional UIC contact for the region in which they are located.

The next section of the access registration forms requests information such as the name, email, work address, and work phone for the state or tribal user. Note that the email address used for the Login.gov account must match the email address used for their EPA Web Application Access account. The user will also create their account password.

The last section of the form requires the user to select the Community or Application for which they are requesting access, as shown in Figure 3. The user should use the drop-down list to select **UIC Data Application**. The final step in creating the account is to check the box to accept the EPA Privacy & Security Notice and click the "Submit Registration" button (Figure 3).

The state or tribal user will receive an email from <u>wam_support@epa.gov</u> after submitting their access registration confirming that they self-registered. EPA UIC program staff will also be alerted to the request, verify the user's UIC program affiliation, and will then approve the request for access to the UIC Data Application.

Once the request is approved, state and tribal users can login to the UIC Data Application at <u>https://uicdata.epa.gov</u> using their Login.gov account.

Information for EPA Users

Access for EPA Users

EPA staff should email <u>uicdatacollection@epa.gov</u> with a request for access. Once EPA HQ has approved their request and configured their accounts, EPA users can log in to the UIC Data Application at <u>https://uicdata.epa.gov</u> using their EPA Single Sign-On Login.

Assisting State and Tribal Users with Access

The EPA instructs state and tribal users who request access to the UIC Data Application to list the EPA Regional Data Management Coordinator (Table 1) as the EPA contact during access registration (Figure 2). The EPA contact will receive an email requesting confirmation that the state or tribal user should receive access to the Application. The Application administrators will be copied on the email to the EPA contact.

The contact should respond using "reply all" to confirm the state or tribal user's access request and include the name of the user's agency.

Only authorized EPA staff and state or tribal UIC program staff will receive access to the Application. If an EPA contact receives a request from organizations other than EPA or primacy UIC programs, please send the request to <u>uicdatacollection@epa.gov</u> so the administrators may contact the requestor. The EPA contact should also give a short explanation for why the requestor should be denied or approved access to the Application.
