PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Ogden City Corporation's Wellfield and Ogden Canyon Water Line Replacement Project will modernize water infrastructure and reduce water loss throughout the system. The city will utilize WIFIA financing to replace the Wellfield Water Line, which delivers groundwater to the water treatment plant, and the Canyon Water Line, which delivers treated drinking water from the water treatment plant to the distribution system. This project will help the city save over 2 million gallons of water per day, which is currently being lost due to water line leaks. With this WIFIA loan, the city will increase water system efficiency and continue to provide reliable drinking water to customers.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- Increases drinking water system efficiency and resiliency.
- Reduces water loss by 2 million gallons per day.
- Saves the Ogden City Corporation approximately \$5 million by financing with a WIFIA loan.
