REPORT OF THE AUDIT DIVISION ON THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL HISPANIC ASSEMBLY

I. Background

A. Overview

This report is based on an audit of the Republican National Hispanic Assembly ("the Committee"), undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Commission's audit policy to determine whether there has been compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The audit was conducted pursuant to Section 433(a)(3) of Title 2 of the United States Code, which directs the Commission to make available to the public and field investigators who request it records and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

The Committee is headquartered with the United States General Accounting Office on August 26, 1971. The Committee is an affiliate of the National National Committee. It maintains its principal office in Washington, D.C.

The audit covered the period January 1, 1976 through December 31, 1978, the final coverage date of the latest report filed by the Committee at the time of the audit. During that period, the Committee reported a beginning cash balance of \$344.30, total receipts of \$107,117.99, total expenditures of \$100,714.70, and a closing cash balance of December 31, 1978 of \$7,110.41.

This audit report is based on documents and working papers which support each of the factual statements. They form part of the evidence on which the Commission based its decision on the matters in this report and were available to the Commission and its agents at the time of review.

C. Key Personnel

The principal officers of the Committee during the period covered by the audit were Benjamin Fernández, Chairman, from January 1, 1976 through August 23, 1978, and Fernando Gómez, Chairman, from August 23, 1978 through December 31, 1978; Frank Cullinan, Treasurer, from January 1, 1976 through October 4, 1977 and Edward Lucero, Treasurer, from December 5, 1977 through December 31, 1978.

C. Scope

The audit included such tests as verification of total reported receipts and expenditures and individual transactions; review of required supporting documentation; analysis of Committee debts and obligations; and, such other audit procedures deemed necessary under the circumstances.

D. Audit Findings

It is the opinion of the Audit staff, based upon examination of the reports and documents filed and the records presented, that the Republican National Hispanic Assembly is not a political committee as defined by section 431(b) of Title 2 of the House Rules of Procedure for the period January 1, 1976 through December 31, 1978, and therefore not subject to the reporting requirements of the law. This opinion is based on the fact that the organization has no members and no offices in connection with its principal activities for the calendar year.

In addition, it is the opinion of the Audit staff, based upon examination of the reports and documents filed and the records presented, that the Republican National Hispanic Assembly has conducted its activities in compliance with the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in all material aspects. The Audit staff is unable to verify that the financial reports filed with the FEC for the period January 1, 1977 through December 31, 1978, are complete.

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
