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REPORT OF THE AUDIT DIVISION ON THE STATE DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF CONNECTICUT/ VOTER REGISTRATION COMMITTEE

I. Background

A. Overview

This report is based on an audit of the State Democratic Party of Connecticut/Voter Registration Committee ("the Committee") undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Commission's audit policy to determine whether there has been compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The audit was conducted pursuant to Section 438(a)(8) of Title 2 of the United States Code which, at the time of the audit, directed the Commission to make from time to time audits and field investigations with respect to reports and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

The Committee registered as the State Democratic Party of Connecticut/Voter Registration Committee with the Federal Election Commission on September 20, 1976. The Committee maintained its headquarters in Hartford, Connecticut.

The audit covered the period from September 2, 1976 through January 31, 1977, the final coverage date of the termination report filed by the Committee.

The Committee reported a beginning cash balance on September 2, 1976 of \$-0-, total receipts of \$45,317.63, total expenditures of \$40,317.63, and a closing cash balance as of January 31, 1977 of \$-0-.

This audit report is based on documents and work papers which support each of its factual statements. They form part of the record upon which the Commission based its decisions on the matters in the report and were available to Commissioners and appropriate staff for review.

B. Key Personnel

The principal officers of the Committee during the period audited were: Harry H. Kleinman, Chairman and Henry Altobello, Treasurer.

C. Scope

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The audit included such tests as verification of reported receipts and expenditures and individual transactions; review of required supporting documentation; analysis of debts and obliquations; and such other audit procedures as deemed necessary under the circumstances.

11. Audit Findings and Recommendations

A matter noted during the audit was referred to the Commission's Office of General Counsel for consideration on September 13, 1979.
