DIRECTORS--Oaths of Office

At the beginning of each term of office, each director of a Federal Reserve Bank and branch, and each Federal Reserve agent and his or her assistant, shall take their oaths on the following appropriate forms:

- Form FR 253--class A directors
- Form FR 254--class B directors
- Form FR 255--class C directors
- Form FR 256--directors of branches
- Form FR 257--Federal Reserve agents, assistant agents, alternate assistant agents, and acting assistant agents, including those at branches.

Other than the oath for class C director, no form of oath is required for the deputy chairman of the board of directors.

The president of each Federal Reserve Bank, or his or her designee, shall be responsible for familiarizing each director of a Federal Reserve Bank or branch with the rules and policies of the Board of Governors regarding the conduct of directors and shall certify, as to each director at the beginning of each term of office, that he or she is satisfied that the director has been provided a thorough explanation of, and understands, those rules and policies.
