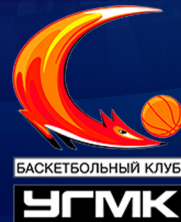

# ISTANBUL AND THE ARENA

**Istanbul: a metropolis of 15 million people, a city divided by Bosphorus, an urban giant on two continents. Shaped by more than 2,600 years of history, Istanbul is regarded as one of the most famous cities in the world. It was the capital of Romans, Byzantines and Ottomans for more than 1,400 years.**

**It has not been the Turkish capital since 1923, but Istanbul is perhaps the most important city in Turkey in terms of finance, business, culture and sports. It is also a popular destination for international tourists as it is not only a modern European city, but one with oriental mystic elements as well. Both oriental and mystic because within a 2,000-year-old historic peninsula, Covered Bazaar, Hagia Sophia, Blue Mosque and Basilica Cistern offer a unique perspective of the glorious past. Arguably, there are very few places in the world where so many huge monuments are within walking distance.**

**At the same time, it is modern with its glittering shopping malls, business districts and high streets. You can spend a whole day in the largest shopping malls of Europe, take your Turkish coffee in the Nisantasi neighbourhood or Bagdat Street.**

**Above all, its uniqueness lies in the fact that it is located on two separate continents. The Bosphorus strait separates the European and Asian parts of the city. Every day, millions of people cross the Bosphorus in a variety of transport modes, including an underwater train. You can travel between Karakoy in Europe and Kadikoy in Asia in just 20 minutes, then sip your Turkish tea and feed the seagulls with 'simit' - a traditional circular bread with sesame seeds. Isn't it magical?**

**Istanbul is also considered the sports capital of Turkey. The 'big three' are Besiktas, Fenerbahce and Galatasaray - all of which are multi-sport clubs with a deep-rooted history and based in Istanbul. While soccer may be considered the number one sport, basketball has a huge following within the city. Various teams from across the city have won numerous titles both in women's and men's basketball including top honors in men's and women's European club competitions.**

Istanbul's love affair with basketball cannot be limited to just the local clubs. The city has also hosted a multitude of premium basketball events in recent years, such as the FIBA Basketball World Cup and FIBA EuroBasket amongst others. Modern, recently built arenas have enabled Istanbul to host the very best of European and world basketball.

The Volkswagen Arena is one of these state-of-the-art arenas that was constructed in 2014 with the multi-purpose facility accommodating almost 5,000 fans in normal times. The arena has also been the home of the Darussafaka Tekfen basketball team since 2015 and has hosted the many great moments the club has enjoyed in European club competitions.

# EuroLeague Women 2020/21 Competition System

The 2020-21 EuroLeague Women season was played in a different format in order to protect the health and guarantee the safety of players, coaches and officials, but also to safeguard a fair competition as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

To allow for minimal travel, the Regular Season was organized with a shorter competition system with teams split into four groups of four teams, rather than two groups of eight teams and the games were played in single-venue hubs.

Only the top two teams in each of the four groups qualified for the Quarter-Finals, with no teams joining EuroCup Women due to calendar restraints.

Each of the Regular Season groups was played in two hubs, with the cities of Istanbul, Girona and Sopron hosting the games that were played in December and the remaining games played in the cities of Bourges, Prague, Salamanca and Schio, in January.

The eight best teams left in the competition then headed to Salamanca and Sopron for the Quarter-Finals hubs in March, with two pairings per hub. The last eight ties were played in aggregate format across two legs as opposed to the usual three-game series.

Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo, Perfumerias Avenida, Sopron Basket and UMMC Ekaterinburg all advanced to the Final Four. The exciting season finale is to be played at the Volkswagen Arena in Istanbul on April 16-18 with no changes made to the traditional format as games are decided in single-leg system.





## Did you know?

**opta** This will be the sixth game between Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo and UMMC Ekaterinburg in the EuroLeague Women since 2011 with the Turkish side winning the last three encounters; four of those five games have ended with a single-digit differential.

**opta** Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo have won 14 of their last 17 games in the EuroLeague Women, with nine of those wins by a margin of 15+ points.

**opta** Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo have 68 steals in the EuroLeague Women 2020-21, while only Sopron Basket had more than them in the competition this season; Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo average 18.8 points off turnovers per game in the last four games in the competition.

**opta** UMMC Ekaterinburg (38.3%) and Fenerbahçe Oznur Kablo (35.7%) are two of the three teams with the highest shooting percentage from the 3P line in the EuroLeague Women this season: only LDLC ASVEL Feminin have a better ratio than them from behind the arc (39.5%).



## ALINA IAGUPOVA

Iagupova made it back-to-back EuroLeague Women MVP awards after another impressive campaign to repeat the accolade she claimed in 2019-20 with the season unable to be completed due to the pandemic. The Ukrainian international returned to the club after re-signing in December and wasted little time in producing more standout performances.

Iagupova is the only player in the competition to average 20+ points per game this season and enters the Final Four in fine form with averages of 22.3 points, 7.6 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game over her last three games in EuroLeague Women action.

## Did you know?

**opta** UMMC Ekaterinburg have won 28 of their last 29 games in the EuroLeague Women, including their last 17 – if they win against Fenerbahce Oznur Kablo they will tally 18 consecutive wins for the first time in the competition.

**opta** UMMC Ekaterinburg average 88.6 points per game, the highest scoring average in the EuroLeague Women 2020-21; they have scored 80+ points in seven of their eight games in the competition this season.

**opta** UMMC Ekaterinburg's Allie Quigley has made 17 shots from behind the arc, a joint-high in the EuroLeague Women this season, alongside Fenerbahce's Kayla McBride; Quigley has scored 53.1% of her attempted 3-pointers, the highest scoring ratio among all players with 15+ attempts in the league in 2020-21.

**opta** Alba Torrens is the only player to have dished 10+ assists in multiple games in the EuroLeague Women this season; her teammate Courtney Vandersloot has dished out 43 assists, the most of any player in the EuroLeague Women this term.

## BREANNA STEWART

Stewart first signed with UMMC Ekaterinburg in the middle of last season after a lengthy absence through injury, but was not able to play as the 2019-20 campaign was cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic.

The 26-year-old made a very impressive comeback in the 2020 WNBA season by leading Seattle Storm to another Championship in the shortened season and added the Finals MVP award to her growing list of individual accolades. A month later, and Stewart was back in action and continued her strong form in Russia.

Stewart was on the floor for 29.1 minutes per game this season with averages of 11.8 points, 5.9 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.1 blocks. When the USA international is on court, that is usually good news for her team with Stewart leading the league in the +/- category with +20.8.























## Did you know?

**opta** This will be the 9th encounter between the two teams in EuroLeague Women since 2011, with Perfumerias Avenida winning five of those games; the two teams have alternated between wins and losses in their last seven matchups in the competition.

**opta** Perfumerias Avenida have won their last nine games in the EuroLeague Women, their longest winning sequence over the last 10 seasons; they have won those nine games by an average differential of 21.3 points.

**opta** Perfumerias Avenida have scored more than 90 points in three different EuroLeague Women games in 2020-21, a joint-high alongside UMMC Ekaterinburg; they have had as many games with more than 90 points this season as in their previous 10 seasons in the competition combined.

**opta** Silvia Dominguez has dished out 5.1 assists per game for Perfumerias Avenida, the most among all players with 25 or fewer minutes per game in the EuroLeague Women 2020-21; however, she made more turnovers (5) than assists (4) in the quarter finals.



## KATIE LOU SAMUELSON

Samuelson brings a calming influence on the floor for her team with the ability to play multiple positions.

The USA international has the potential to cause matchup issues for Avenida's opponents and her versatility has been a major strength for Roberto Iniguez and his team throughout the campaign.

Samuelson is the only player to score 25+ points on three separate occasions in EuroLeague Women this season, but was held to a best of 11 points in her last three games in the competition.

## Did you know?

**opta** Sopron Basket (63.1) and Perfumerias Avenida (63.4) are two of the three teams to have conceded the fewest points per game in the EuroLeague Women 2020-21, with the Hungarians being the team with the fewest points conceded per game in the league this season.

**opta** Sopron Basket have grabbed 8.4 offensive rebounds per game, the fewest of any team in the EuroLeague Women 2020-21; however, they had 20 offensive rebounds in their most recent game in the competition, a joint-high for a team in a single game in the league this season.

**opta** Sopron Basket have lost their most recent EuroLeague Women game putting an end to their longest winning run over the past 10 seasons. (W7)

**opta** Jelena Brooks has scored 19+ points in three of her last four appearances with Sopron Basket in the EuroLeague Women; she has made 53.1% of her attempted field goals, 58.3% from behind the arc and 91.7% from the FT line in that four-game span.



# GABBY WILLIAMS

The 24-year-old forward has been a constant threat for Sopron by filling up the stat-sheet on any given night. So, it is no surprise to see Williams' name amongst the top of the EuroLeague Women charts in multiple categories.

The American-French dual national ranks fifth in scoring with 16.8 points per game with Alina Iagupova the only other player amongst the Final Four teams in the top five. Williams is the joint-leader in steals with 2.3 per game alongside Sarah Michel as well as featuring in the top 10 for average efficiency rating.

Williams collected a total of 18 steals in eight EuroLeague Women games this season, with no other player collecting more, whilst registering two steals in six of those eight encounters.

# LOOKING BACK

## History

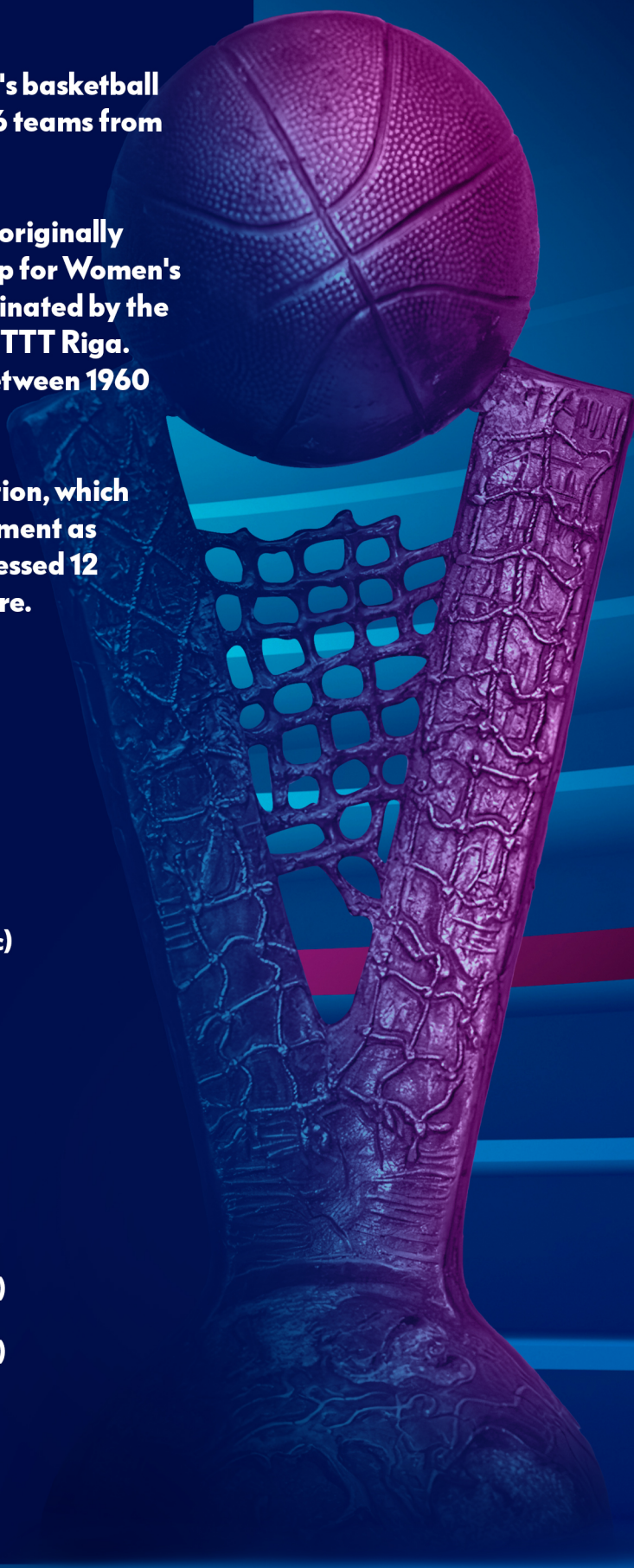
EuroLeague Women is the premier women's basketball competition in Europe, featuring the top 16 teams from the continent and the world's best players.

It has a long and illustrious history, having originally been launched in 1958 as the European Cup for Women's Champion Clubs. It was subsequently dominated by the famous Daugava Riga club, now known as TTT Riga. They made 18 appearances in the finals between 1960 and 1982 - winning all of them.

During the the modern era of the competition, which started after the rebranding of the tournament as EuroLeague Women in 1996, we have witnessed 12 different clubs lifting the precious silverware.
