## PROHIBITED ITEMS





Liquids, aerosols and gels in quantities greater than 100ml

**Drinks**, including **alcohol**, beer, soft drinks, water

Flasks, thermos

Glass bottles (excluding medication contained in glass bottles up to 100ml)



More than one soft-sided must be able to fit your bag



**Working tools** 



**Noisemakers** such as hunting horns, air horns, klaxons, megaphones, vuvuzelas and whistles



**Motorcycle helmets** 



**Baby carriage** 



jammers and radio scanners

Personal/private mobile network hubs (smart devices such as Android phones, iPhone and tablets are permitted inside venues, but must not be used as wireless access points to connect multiple devices)

Laser pointers and strobe lights



Items too large to be electronically screened



Bicycles, folding bikes, roller-skates and skateboards



Pets or animals (excluding service animals)





Explosives, flares and smoke canisters

Any kind of flammable/ explosive substances, liquids or gases or other flammable substances including but not limited to fireworks



**Hazardous** and toxic materials



Controlled drugs, including substances which look like controlled drugs



Tents, placards, spray paint or any other item which could be used to demonstrate within the venue or sabotage property



Offensive weapons or implements such as bayonets, flick knives, extendable batons, sharpened combs, modified belt buckles and loose blades modified into weapons

Items that resemble prohibited items such as replica guns or hoax explosive devices

**Personal protection sprays** such as CS or pepper sprays

Firearms and ammunition (including replicas, component parts or any device suspected to be a firearm)



Video cameras, regardless of size, model, range and selfie sticks

Any telephoto lens above 150mm aperture including tripods and monopods.

You cannot use photographic or broadcast equipment for commercial purposes unless you hold media accreditation



Poles (i.e. flag poles) of hard material and/or longer than 1 meter



Balls, rackets, frisbees or similar objects or projectiles



All other objects and substances that might endanger security, public health, public order and/or reputation of FIBA, Local Organising Committee and venue



Paper rolls (including toilet paper, cash register rolls, confetti)



Any flags except the official country flags of the teams participating in a FIBA competition



**Drones and remotes** 



"Excessive amount of food" - people should be allowed to bring a sandwich or some snacks

The items above are not allowed in the venues of FIBA competition. Persons carrying any of the items above will not be allowed into the venues and may be transferred to the local law enforcement representatives.
