FLRA Launches New FOIA Processing System

The Federal Labor Relations Authority is pleased to announce that the Authority recently purchased and implemented new software to manage its Freedom of Information Act requests: FOIAXpress®. *See* 5 C.F.R. § 2411.5. FOIAXpress® is a document management software program developed by AINS, LLC d/b/a OPEXUS.

FOIAXpress® will assist the Authority in processing Freedom of Information Act requests more efficiently to better serve the public. While requests may continue to be submitted by e-mail and mail as in the past, following May 31, 2024, when submitting FOIA requests to the Authority, we encourage you to submit your request at <u>FOIA.FLRA.gov</u>. The website contains registration instructions. Once a new account is registered, FOIA requesters may sign in, access and download from the reading room documents provided in response to FOIA requests.
