- 6 tigation building under construction at the intersection of

- 1 120th and L Streets in Omaha, Nebraska, shall be known
- 2 and designated as the "J. James Exon Federal Bureau
- 3 of Investigation Building".
- 4 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 6 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 7 be deemed to be a reference to the J. James Exon Federal
- 8 Bureau of Investigation Building.
