
LAURENCE GILMAN

SENIOR VICE-PRESIDENT AND GOVERNOR, TORONTO MARLIES

Laurence Gilman enters his sixth season with the organization and holds the position of Senior Vice-President of the Marlies. He also currently serves as Chairman of the Executive Committee of the American Hockey League's Board of Governors.

Prior to joining the Maple Leafs, Gilman served on the NHL's Expansion Draft Rules and Regulations Committee where he helped formulate and design the rules and regulations for the 2017 NHL Expansion Draft. From 2008 to 2015, Gilman worked for the Vancouver Canucks and most recently served as the Canucks' Vice President of Hockey Operations & Assistant General Manager. Before joining the Canucks, Gilman was with the Phoenix Coyotes/Winnipeg Jets organization for 13 years and served as the club's Senior Vice President & Assistant General Manager from 2002 to 2007. Gilman also served as General Manager of the AHL's San Antonio Rampage and Utah Grizzlies during his time in the organization.

RYAN HARDY

GENERAL MANAGER, TORONTO MARLIES
ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER, MINOR LEAGUE OPERATIONS, TORONTO MAPLE LEAFS

Ryan Hardy is in his third season with the Toronto Maple Leafs organization. He was named Assistant General Manager, Minor League Operations on July 5, 2022. He oversees hockey operations for the Marlies and Newfoundland Growlers (ECHL), including roster decisions and staffing, while working in partnership with the Player Development department to track drafted prospects and participate in player personnel and scouting initiatives as needed.

Hardy held the role of General Manager with the Chicago Steel (USHL) beginning in May of 2018. The Steel compiled a regular season record of 116-39-8-2 in 165 games for the most wins in the league over that stretch. The club won the Anderson Cup as the league's regular season champion in each of the last two seasons while it captured the USHL's Clark Cup Champion in 2020-21. He was named the USHL's General Manager of the Year in two of this three seasons (2018-19, 2020-21). In the 2019-20 season, the Steel set the USHL record for highest winning percentage (.847) in the shortened season.

Hardy joined the Steel from the Boston Bruins where he spent two seasons as an amateur scout. Prior to joining the Bruins, Hardy spent parts of four season (2013-17) with USA Hockey's National Team Development Program, serving as Director of Player Personnel, Assistant Director of Player Personnel and Regional Scouting Manager during that time.

MIKE DIXON

ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER AND ALTERNATE GOVERNOR, TORONTO MARLIES
DIRECTOR OF MINOR LEAGUE OPERATIONS, TORONTO MAPLE LEAFS

Mike Dixon is in his seventh season with the Toronto Marlies Hockey Club and his fourth as Assistant General Manager. Dixon also serves as Director of Minor League Operations for the Toronto Maple Leafs organization and oversees the day-to-day operations of both the Marlies and the organization's ECHL affiliate, the Newfoundland Growlers. During his time with the Maple Leafs, Dixon has overseen both the Marlies 2018 Calder Cup Championship and the Growlers 2019 Kelly Cup Championship.

With more than 10 years of experience in the NHL, Dixon previously held a variety of positions with the Florida Panthers including as Director of Hockey Operations from 2013 to 2016. The Stoney Creek, ON native graduated from Florida Atlantic University with an MBA in in Sports Management in 2007 and received a Bachelor of Commerce degree from McMaster University in 2003.

JOHN GRUDEN

HEAD COACH

John Gruden is in his first season as the eighth head coach of the Marlies. Gruden, 53, joins the Marlies after serving as Assistant Coach this past season with the Boston Bruins and previously held the same position from 2018-22 with the New York Islanders. As head coach of the Hamilton Bulldogs (OHL), he led the club to the 2018 OHL Championship and compiled a record of 76-45-8-7 through two seasons (2016-18). Gruden also served as head coach for the Flint Firebirds (OHL) during the 2015-16 season. He began his coaching career as an assistant coach with the US NTDP Juniors (USHL) from 2011-15, helping lead Team USA to gold medals at both the 2012 and 2014 U18 World Championships.

The Virginia, Minnesota native appeared in 92 NHL games and 175 AHL games after being selected in the eighth round (168th overall) of the 1990 NHL Draft by the Boston Bruins. Prior to his professional career, Gruden recorded 104 points (40 goals, 64 assists) in 155 games at Ferris State University and was named NCAA (CCHA) Best Offensive Defenseman and to the NCAA (CCHA) First All-Star Team and NCAA (West) First All-American Team in 1993-94.

RICH CLUNE

ASSISTANT COACH

Rich Clune, 36, joins the Marlies bench as an assistant coach. He previously served on the Toronto Maple Leafs staff as a player development coach since announcing his retirement from his playing career in August 2022. The former Marlies captain recorded 25 goals and 34 assists in 256 regular season games over seven seasons with the Marlies. He also recorded five points in 20 playoff contests, capturing the Calder Cup championship with the Marlies in 2018.

The Toronto native played in 139 regular season NHL games with the Maple Leafs, Nashville Predators and Los Angeles Kings while skating in 593 regular season AHL games with the Marlies, Milwaukee Admirals, Manchester Monarchs and Iowa Stars. Clune was originally selected by Dallas in the third round (71st overall) of the 2005 NHL Draft.

MICHAEL DYCK

ASSISTANT COACH

Michael Dyck, 54, has more than 25 years in coaching and management roles at the junior and international levels of hockey. He joins the Marlies after serving as head coach of the Vancouver Giants (WHL) where he compiled a record of 144-120-17-7 through five seasons. He previously held coaching roles with the Medicine Hat Tigers, Lethbridge Hurricanes and Kootenay Ice.

Internationally, the Lethbridge, Alberta native was an assistant coach with the Canadian World Junior team, earning a silver medal in 2021 and a gold medal in 2022, as well as capturing a gold medal at the 2021 IIHF World Championships. Dyck also was a member of the coaching staff at the Hlinka Gretzky Cup, Youth Olympic Games and the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge.

ERIC WELLWOOD

ASSISTANT COACH

Eric Wellwood, 33, spent the past two seasons as head coach of the Newfoundland Growlers (ECHL). He compiled a regular season record of 90-42-6-1 and led the club to the Eastern Conference Final in consecutive seasons. The Oldcastle, Ontario native previously was head coach with the Flint Firebirds (2018-21) and assistant coach with the Oshawa Generals (2014-16) and the Windsor Spitfires (2013-14). With the Generals, he captured both the OHL Championship and the Memorial Cup in 2014-15.

Wellwood was selected in the sixth round (172nd overall) in the 2009 NHL Draft by the Philadelphia Flyers. He appeared in 164 career AHL games, recording 66 points (34 goals, 32 assists) and 31 career NHL games, collecting five goals and five assists, all with the Philadelphia organization. Prior to his professional career, he captured back-to-back Memorial Cup championships with the Windsor Spitfires.

HANNU TOIVONEN

GOALTENDING COACH

Hannu Toivonen is in his third season as goaltending coach. The Kalvola, Finland native was drafted 29th overall in 2002 NHL Draft by the Boston Bruins. During his career, he played in 61 NHL games and 214 AHL games before returning to Finland where he appeared in 208 Liiga games. Toivonen, 37, previously held the role of goaltending coach with the University of New England (NCAA III) and managed his own goaltending school in New England.

TROY PAQUETTE

VIDEO COACH

Troy Paquette enters his third season as the Toronto Marlies' video coach. He joins the Marlies following his role as Video Coach and Team Services Coordinator with the Kingston Frontenacs of the Ontario Hockey League. Paquette had been with the Frontenacs since 2018. The Kingston native also worked as the Goaltending Coach for the Queen's University men's hockey team
