**HISTORY:** Hershey Gardens was opened by Milton S. Hershey in 1937 as

> Hershey Rose Garden. Originally just 3½ acres, the Gardens reached 23 acres in 1944. It was renamed Hershey Gardens in 1979, when it boasted six themed gardens. The Children's Garden opened in 2003 and the Milton & Catherine Hershey Conservatory opened in 2016. Hershey Gardens is an operating

division of the nonprofit M.S. Hershey Foundation.
