

Road Test Required Documents: **Proof of Insurance**

City and County of Honolulu • Department of Customer Services

Road test applicants must present a current Hawaii motor vehicle insurance card.

- The name(s) and vehicle identification number (VIN) must be the same as the name(s) and VIN on the vehicle certificate or registration.
- Original documents only: photocopied, faxed or computer printed documents are not accepted.

Road test applicants may also provide an **electronic version** of the motor vehicle insurance identification card, which is accessible directly through the license insurer's website, application or database.

ELECTRONIC PROOF OF INSURANCE (EPI) Complete Steps 1-3 prior to Road Test check-in

STEP 1.  Go to your Android or Apple App store

STEP 2.  Download mobile app of your insurance company

STEP 3.  Set up your mobile app account

STEP 4.  Access the electronic version of your motor vehicle insurance ID card. Items 1 & 3 must match valid vehicle registration, and phone with EPI must be in vehicle and accessible by applicant during the road test

1. Vehicle name, make, year, and VIN
2. Policy number
3. Name(s) of the insured and the insurer
4. Effective dates of coverage including the expiration date

- **The mobile app must be downloaded prior to checking in for the appointment.**
- The mobile phone with the electronic version must be carried by the applicant during the road test.
- Road test applicants are also allowed to present a **screenshot** of an electronic insurance identification card on a mobile device that must be carried by the applicant during the road test.
