Subject: Postponement of In-Person ACE Events & Alternatives to Meet Requirements

Discussion: Due to the continuing impacts of COVID-19 on travel and large scale gatherings, the in-person ACE events that were scheduled for the spring of 2022 in San Diego, CA and Anchorage, AK have been postponed to 2023.

The OAS Training Branch and USFS partners are committed to ensuring field personnel and their respective management are able to receive their required training. In order to meet these training needs, we will be increasing the number of distance learning opportunities and select, (smaller scaled) in-person training from January 2022 through May 2022.
