II. IAU WiA WG Training Program Series-2

The IAU Women in Astronomy Training Program series - 2 on 'Essential Skills for Astronomy Research' was organized from Jan 10th-14th, 2022, for worldwide female students and researcher in Astronomy. 112 participants (73.5% female, 25.7% male, 1% other genders) at different career stages and from 30 countries registered for the 2nd Training Program series (Fig. 1). 39% participants held permanent positions and 61% were non permanent researchers and students (45%).

The Training Program series focused on:

- -TOPCAT- astronomy catalog matching software- Priya Hasan



The motivation of the participants to attend this Training Program series was to improve their imaging analysis, catalog handling, and research skills, as it is not offered in their coursework, acquire the skills with which they can train next generation of researchers, and create a self supporting and helpful international network of students and researchers in astronomy. A Participation certificate signed by the IAU President and the WiA WG chair and Co-Chair was provided to the attendees and the 'Best Training Program participant' was announced at the end of the Training program.

A summary of feedback received from these participants are as below-

- '-Thank you IAU WiA WG for the 2nd Training Program. I am glad that this 2nd program has addressed different topics.
- -I think topics such as time management would be very useful. Also, more sessions on programming techniques (Astropy) would be very useful to be a better researcher. Unfortunately, there is a culture in our world in which men are perceived as better programmers than women, so it can be difficult to have the necessary confidence to do a good job related with programming, and those lessons are helping to solve this problem in practice.
- -Thanks for conducting such an informative session. Looking forward for more such sessions.
- -This entire program is an excellent initiative by the IAU WiA WG. I'm looking forward to attending more such programs organized by you in the coming future.
