RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Ms. Massignan,

Please be advised that as of 12 January 2015, ELB Group Inc ("ELB Group") is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 13 September 2014 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

1. ELB Group's failure to provide domain name data in the specified response format, as required by Section 1.4 of the Registration Data Directory Service (Whois) Specification of the RAA ("Whois Specification").

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach.

In addition, ELB Group has been deemed noncompliant in the following areas:

- Failure to publish the full name and position of all officers of the registrar on ELB Group's website, as required by Section 3.17 and Section 17 of the Registrar Information Specification ("RIS") of the RAA;
- 2. Failure to publish an email address to receive abuse reports on the home page of ELB Group's website, as required by Section 3.18.1 of the RAA;



- 3. Failure to publish a description of ELB Group's procedures for the receipt, handling, and tracking of abuse reports, as required by Section 3.18.3 of the RAA;
- 4. Failure to display ELB Group's deletion and auto-renewal policies on ELB Group's website, as required by Section 3.7.5.5 of the RAA; and
- 5. Failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees in the amount of \$3,072.19, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

ICANN requests that ELB Group cure the breaches by 3 February 2015, 21 calendar days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

- 1. Display domain name data in the specified response format, as required by Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification;
- 2. Publish on ELB Group's website the full name and position of all officers of ELB Group;
- 3. Publish an email address to receive abuse reports on the home page of ELB Group's website;
- 4. Publish a description of ELB Group's procedures for the receipt, handling, and tracking of abuse reports on ELB Group's website;
- 5. Publish ELB Group's deletion and auto-renewal policies details on ELB Group's website; and
- 6. Pay all past due accreditation fees of \$3,072.19.

If ELB Group fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 3 February 2015, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

ATTACHMENT

Failure to use required Whois format

Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification of the RAA requires registrars to display domain name data in a specified format for Whois query responses. The format of responses shall contain all the elements and follow a semi-free text format outlined in Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification. ELB Group's failure to display Whois data in the specified format is a breach of Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification of the RAA.

Failure to publish the full name and position of all officers on registrar's website

Section 3.17 of the RAA requires registrars to maintain and provide to ICANN the information specified in the RIS. ELB Group's failure to publish the full name and position of all of its officers on its website is a breach of Section 3.17 of the RAA and the RIS.

Failure to publish an email address to receive reports of abuse

Section 3.18.1 of the RAA requires registrars to publish on the home page of their websites an email address to receive abuse reports. ELB Group's failure to publish an email address on the home page of its website to receive abuse reports is a breach of Section 3.18.1 of the RAA.

Failure to publish a description of procedures for receipt, handling and tracking of abuse reports

Section 3.18.3 of the RAA requires registrars to publish on their websites a description of their procedures for the receipt, handling, and tracking of abuse reports. ELB Group's failure to publish a description of its procedures for the receipt, handling, and tracking of abuse reports on its website is a breach of Section 3.18.3 of the RAA.

Failure to publish deletion and auto-renewal policies on registrar's website

Section 3.7.5.5 of the RAA requires registrars that operate a website for domain name registration or renewal to clearly display details of a registrar's deletion and auto-renewal policies on the registrar's website. ELB Group's failure to clearly display its deletion and auto-renewal policies on its website is a breach of Section 3.7.5.5 of the RAA.



Failure to pay accreditation fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. ELB Group owes ICANN \$3,072.19 in past due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
