## DDOT Traffic Advisory: Right Lane Closure on I-295 Southbound between Exit 2 - South Capitol St./Malcolm X Ave./JBAB and Exit 1 -US Naval Research Lab/Blue Plains July 20, 2022

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close the southbound right lane on I-295 between Exits 1 and 2 for milling and paving.

The roadwork will occur Wednesday, July 20, 2022, from 7AM-2PM, weather permitting.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
