ANAHEIM-SANTA ANA-IRVINE METROPOLITAN DIVISION (ORANGE COUNTY) Nonfarm payrolls down 2,100 over the month; up 31,100 over the year

The unemployment rate in Orange County was 4.4 percent in July 2024, up from a revised 4.0 percent in June 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.8 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between June 2024 and July 2024, total nonfarm employment decreased from 1,707,000 to 1,704,900, a loss of 2,100 jobs.

- Two sectors declined over the month. Government decreased the most, with a seasonal loss of 9,200 jobs. The majority of the drop was in local government (down 8,400 jobs), due to the summer recess. State government decreased by 1,000 jobs and federal government gained 200 jobs. Information declined by 100 jobs.
- Two industry sectors expanded by more than 1,000 payroll jobs each. Professional and business services increased the most, gaining 3,600 jobs. Leisure and hospitality added 1,100 jobs.
- Six other industry sectors had over the month employment increases, contributing 2,500 additional jobs. Mining and logging remained the same.


Between July 2023 and July 2024, total nonfarm employment increased by 31,100 jobs, or 1.9 percent.

- Private education and health services (up 16,500 jobs) accounted for more than half of the total year-over increase. Seventy-one percent of the gain was in health care and social assistance (up 11,700 jobs). Private educational services expanded by 4,800 jobs.
- Seven industry sectors contributed the remaining 18,900 payroll jobs. Leisure and hospitality had the largest increase, gaining 5,500 jobs. Year-over payroll gains were reported in arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 3,700 jobs) and accommodation and food services (up 1,800 jobs).
- Employment declines were reported in two sectors: manufacturing (down 2,900 jobs) and information (down 1,400 jobs). Mining and logging had no employment changes over the year.
