Senator Jim Pehler gave a brief introduction and welcomed the committee to the St. Cloud community after which Rep. McEachern introduced the topic of discussion.

Rep. McEachern announced the appointment of Rep. Andy Dawkins to the Education Committee.

The topic of discussion dealt with the following questions which were addressed by each of the speakers below.

- 1. Minnesota law requires all residents between the ages of 7 and 16 to attend school. What do you feel would be the impact of raising the age of compulsory attendance to age 17 or 18?
- Minnesota law provides a free public education to any resident under the age of 21. Would you favor removing the age limit for anyone who hasn't completed their last two years of high school?
- 3. What are the early childhood education needs and priorities of your school district? If funds were made available, would you favor all-day kindergarten or prefer programs for four-year-old at-risk children?
- 4. The School Start Law prohibits districts from beginning the school year before Labor Day. Has this caused your district any problems?
- 5. Should the school day or year be lengthened? Would student achievement increase with more time on task?
- 6. What other concerns do you have for the 1988 legislative session?
