
LIVE INTERACTIVE SESSIONS CONNECTING STUDENTS AND FACULTY.

In conversation with Ms. Ginni Nijhawan

The Covid-19 pandemic has spurred the public interest to fulfil their academic needs over the internet. Continuing with the trend and setting the bar high in online learning, LPU is a premier Education provider offering world-class education with its people-friendly platform of 'LPU Online'. Ms. Ginni Nijhawan, the Head of Wing, Centre for Distance & Online Education, LPU, enlightens us about the questions surrounding online education.



For the past 15 years, you have been a pillar of strength for LPU's domain of Distance education. How does the leap from Distance to Online make you feel?

Before online education came into existence, our Distance Education students at LPU were already leveraging online learning tools such as Learning Management System, live/recorded lectures, Discussion Forum and more. So, transitioning from Distance to Online has been a smooth ride. In fact, it enabled us to expand our global reach and bring diversity to our classrooms.

The pandemic disrupted the education sector, making online learning a reasonable alternative to traditional learning. What challenges did you face in making it accessible to the masses?

Today, a large number Indians from smaller cities and villages are also tech-savvy, owing to easy access to smartphones and high-speed data. So, providing accessibility is not a challenge anymore. However, our top priority is to tackle the real challenge of regular upgradation of academic resources and curriculum and bringing it to the masses before the course/programme or technology goes obsolete.

Despite the growing public interest in online education and a rapid increase in the number of players, what does the future hold according to you?

Today, hundreds of universities globally offer quality education online, and 60+ top-ranking Indian universities are part of the league. In my opinion, online education will soon become a global standard for acquiring skills.



How credible are online degrees, which are generally pocket-friendly, in contrast to the ones delivered on-campus that require huge investment of funds?

LPU Online learners are being offered degree programmes at a highly affordable fee structure, but they get access to the same curriculum taught by the same faculty. Our degree adds value to the resumes of both online and offline learners, equally. As per UGC, an online degree is equivalent to a regular degree. So, credibility is not an issue because what matters is one's knowledge and skill.

As a student, one would always like to interact directly with his/her faculty members, peers and industry experts, but won't it be lacking in a virtual classroom?

Active and passive learners make up every classroom, and their level of interaction is entirely subjective. For our online learners, there are discussion forums, chat rooms and one-to-one sessions with their professors and mentors. With so much on the platter, interactions can never be dull.

One crucial thing that intrigues the student community is the employer's perspective towards online learners. Are online graduates as valuable as regular ones?

In today's day and age, employers look for and recruit deserving skilled candidates, irrespective of their mode of education for high-paid jobs. It's a thing of the past when degrees and grades were valued over skillset. That's the reason why regular upskilling has become the need of the hour.

Talking about the international students who are ready to grow their horizons of knowledge and skills, are you able to reach out to global learners?

Technology and communication have made it extremely easy for us to reach out to learners globally. Indian Education system has takers across the world, which is evident from the fact that we already have learners from more than 30 countries enrolled in various online programmes, with BCA and MA being most sought-after.

Last but not the least, please share with everyone, the top 5 learnings you have gained in your professional tenure.

- There is no replacement for hard work.
- Do what needs to be done, even if no one is watching, even if you are not going to get the credit for it.
- There is so much learning, if you are ready to step out of your comfort zone.
- As a leader, get ready to take a little more blame and a little lesser credit.
- Take decisions based on data and not perceptions.

LPU'S MITTAL SCHOOL OF BUSINESS RANKED AMONGST THE TOP IN INDIA

IIRF Ranking 2023

A significant jump of 43 spots has brought Mittal School of Business at Lovely Professional University (LPU) to the 41st rank amongst 2900 private B schools nationwide.

- North Zone Rank 5 and overall 21st in the list of 'top 45 business schools under university program in India 2023'.
- Overall 48th and North Zone rank 15 in the 'top 50 business schools for research in India 2023'.
- With a score of 720.27, it is ahead of many government institutions including IIM, Bodh Gaya (716.86); IIFM, Bhopal (710.70); FMS, Vadodara (706.10); Indian Maritime University, Chennai (703.70); and many more.
