Janine Mattson presented a request for MSRS (MN State Retirement System) buyback for seven (7) individuals (See attached.)

Senator Hughes moved passage of the MSRS buyback request. The motion carried.

Pat Flahaven presented Senate Resolution #12 relating to mileage.

Senator Luther moved the adoption of Senate Resolution #12. The motion carried.

Pat Flahaven answered questions regarding Senate mileage and living expenses.

Senator Luther moved adoption of SC9505 (attached) setting the mileage and living expenses as follows:

mileage - 27.5 cents/mile air fare - actual cost living expenses - up to \$50/day

- 3 Each member of the Senate who has moved from the member's
- 4 usual place of lodging during a substantial part of the sessions
- 5 of the 77th Legislature shall be reimbursed for necessary travel
- 6 in going to and returning from the place of meeting to the
- 7 member's place of residence for each trip during the 77th
- 8 Legislature. Mileage must be at the rate of 27.5 cents per
- 9 mile, or any greater amount authorized by the internal revenue
- 10 service for employees. Airfare must be the actual cost.
- 11 Each member of the Senate shall be paid per diem living
- 12 expenses in an amount up to \$50 for each calendar day during the
- 13 sessions of the 77th Legislature.
- Each member of the Senate shall be reimbursed up to \$450
- 15 per month for actual lodging expenses during the sessions of the
- 16 77th Legislature.
- 17 Each member of the Senate shall certify in writing to the
- 18 Secretary of the Senate for the actual travel and lodging for
- 19 which the member seeks reimbursement.
- The Secretary of the Senate shall prepare and issue
- 21 warrants from the Senate legislative expense fund in payment of
- 22 mileage and living expenses to each member of the Senate.
