#### BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Administration:

- 1. In addition to per diem living expenses, each member of the Senate who resides more than 50 miles from the State Capitol shall be reimbursed up to \$1,500 per month for actual lodging expenses. The total reimbursement for those members, per diem plus lodging, may not exceed the amount per legislative day allowed by the Internal Revenue Service for an accountable plan.
- 2. Each member shall be reimbursed for up to \$200 per month for expenses for telecommunications.
- 3. Each member of the Senate shall certify in writing to the Secretary of the Senate for 1.11 the actual living and telecommunication expenses for which the member seeks reimbursement. 1.12 The amounts specified for reimbursement in this resolution apply to expenses incurred after 1.13 December 31, 2013. 1.14
