Data Notes:

[1] Where MCDs/Census Blocks become combined, the "Population Change" accounts for the base numbers for the previous period for all groups included. This cannot be achieved for Blocks which are broken out of another; in these cases no total is provided.

[2] The US Census currently or formerly, and incorrectly, grouped several assorted islands with organized communities, including those listed below. The 2000 and 2010 U.S. Census information includes sufficient detail to enable the proper separation of these areas; the results of the incorrect groupings have been overcome and therefore properly reflected for those periods herein.

[2a] Metinic, Little Green and Big Green Islands were grouped with Vinalhaven Town in 1990 and 2000 instead of Matinicus Isle Pt;

[2b] A number of islands within the Penobscot Bay Group - Sheet 5 in Knox County continue to be grouped with the Towns of North Haven and Vinalhaven;

[2c] Muscle Ridge Shoals Twp (13803) was grouped with Town of Vinalhaven, until the 2000 Census;

[2d] Louds Island (65185) was grouped with the Town of Bristol, until the 2000 Census;

[2e] a number of islands within the Penobscot Bay Island Groups in Hancock County continue to be grouped with Town of Deer Isle; and

[2f] Hungry Island in the Muscongus Bay Group in Lincoln County is listed with the Town of Bremen.

[3] Some minor civil divisions have organized or deorganized since 1970 and therefore have been included or excluded at various times into or from different U.S. Census blocks. These figures exclude those towns that organized and include historic data for those towns that deorganized in order to account for the changes. This factor also influences the total figures for "Unorganized Townships" and "Plantations/Towns", above.

[4] While census blocks are typically defined by MCD boundaries, four exceptions in the 2000 Census and 2010 Census exist:

[4a] the Square Lake UT and Northwest Aroostook UT blocks are divided by the Montreal Maine Atlantic Railway;

[4b] the Northwest Piscataquis UT and Northeast Piscataquis UT blocks are divided by the Telos and Churchill Dam Roads;

[4c] the Northwest Somerset UT and Northeast Somerset UT blocks are divided by Route 201; and

[4d] the Northeast Somerset UT and Seboomook Lake UT blocks are divided by the Moose River Road, Brassua Road, Demo Road, and Spinney Road.

[5] The Town of Chester annexed 2,800 acres of T2 R8 NWP in 1997, although as of January 1, 2011 that annexed portion has not been incorporated into the town's ordinances and therefore remains under the jurisdiction of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission. The U.S. Census recognizes the annexed portion as part of the Town of Chester yet these figures cannot identify or report data for that annexed land area.

[6] Many of these islands are not associated with any town, plantation, or township.
