





GATLINBURG, Tenn. - The second day of searching for a 16-year-old girl reported lost near Clingman's Dome in Great Smoky Mountains National Park ended Sunday with no sign of the girl lost since Friday.

Searchers plan to look for her again Monday, but fewer men will be involved in the search. Western North Carolina rescue squad leader David Bossard said Sunday.

Treeny Gibson of Knoxville, Tenn., was reported lost from a Bearden High School trip to Clingman's Dome Friday.

Searchers looked for her Friday night, Saturday and Sunday.

Efforts Saturday and Sunday involved more than 200 volunteers and about 30 park rangers, plus aerial searches by the Tennessee Air National Guard, Bossard said.

"Monday there will be maybe 30 volunteers from Western North Carelina. 20 from Tennessee and 50 rangers," Bossard said.

"We don't feel like she's there. She was lost near a parking lot and less than a quarter of a mile from a road on a paved trail.

"That intensive a search would have found her if she was in that area." Bossard said.

Officials believe the girl found her way to a road and got a ride out of the area, joined a band of hikers on the Appalachian Trail, was never lost to begin with or is dead. Bossard said.

"Let's face it. It was below freezing up there and there was a 15 mile an hour wind that put it about zero (degrees). There was ice in the trees up there this morning and it's going on the third night." Bossard said.

More than 50 volunteers from the Buncombe area were with the 200 volunteer searchers.

## Trenny Reward Offered

A \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of parties involved in the disappearance of Trenny Gibson is being offered by the state, Gov. Ray Blanton's office confirmed Thursday.

Trenny Gibson, a 16-year-old Bearden High School student, was last seen Oct. 8 in the Clingman's Dome area of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. An intensive search was launched, which at one time involved more than 200 people. The National Park Service has since discontinued an organized search.

Trent Hall, an assistant in the governor's office, said papers are being prepared for the reward at the request of several East Tennessee legislators.

Legislators who led the effort for issuance of the reward are State Reps. Ted Ray Miller, Tom Jensen, Bill Nolan, Loy Smith and Jim Richards; and State Sens. Ben Atchley and Victor Ashe.

Robert Gibson, father of Trenny, said he is pleased with the state's reward offer.

"I feel this is a fine gesture on the part of the governor's office to help bring our daughter home," he said.

## VOLUNTEER SEARCHERS PRAISED AS PARK SEARCH FOR TRENNY GIBSON WINDS DOWN

(GATLINBURG, TN) - The intensive search renewed on April 18, in which Park Rangers and volunteers combed the Clingmans Dome area of Great Smoky Mountains National Park, where Trenny Gibson disappeared six months ago, has been completed. The renewed search, using a line-sweep system for intensive coverage of the area of highest probability, was an effort to find some clue which would lead to a conclusion as to what happened to the 16-year-old Knoxville girl last October. A large area around the point of disappearance, and along trails and drainages radiating from there, was covered.

"Searchers have again gone to great lengths in extremely rugged mountain areas to find any clues to Trenny's disappearance, but after extensive search no evidence has been found," said Superintendent Boyd Evison. "Rescue Squad members from both North Carolina and Tennessee are to be commended for their unselfish efforts to aid in the Gibson family's efforts to find Trenny. Squad members, volunteer coordinators, and medical support teams have contributed their considerable talents and leadership in spite of other pressures on their time."

"With all the effort expended on this search, the fact still remains that there is a possibility she is still in the Park," Evison said. "That possibility will stay in our minds every time we go into the backcountry, I'm sure."

## Father hopes TV show will take up case of missing girl

The father of a girl reported missing in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park in 1976 and never found says he hopes to get his daughter's story on the television program "Unsolved Mysteries."

Bob Gibson's 16-year-old daughter, Trenny, was reported missing in the Park Oct. 8, 1976. Both Gibson and his wife said at the time of the initial search for their daughter, they suspected foul play.

Gibson said Monday he still believes foul play was involved and that his daughter was abducted. It is that belief that has led him to work with Channel 10 to get his daughter's story aired on "Unsolved Mysteries," he said.

Trenny Gibson, who was described as a "quiet sort of girl" by her friends, had accompanied fellow students from Bearden High School on a field trip in the Park Friday, Oct. 8, 1976. Gibson, along with horticulture classmates, had hiked to Andrews Bald and was returning to Clingman's Dome.

Gibson was walking a few yards in front of the other students. She was last seen one mile from the Clingman's Dome parking lot.

"That's the last we saw of her,"

An initial search began late Friday evening, with 150 people, including members of the Sevier County Rescue Squad, searching along the trial and in backwoods areas surrounding the trail.

Temperatures that weekend were in the low 30s, and two searchers had to be treated for hypothermia. Another searcher fell and cracked his ribs. By Mon-

day morning, Trenny Gibson had still not been found.

Searchers did find three cigarette butts and a "fresh" beer can along the Andrews Bald trail. Scent dogs followed a scent believed to be that of the lost girl to a spot near Clingman's Dome, where eight cigarette butts of the same brand as the three found earlier were discovered.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation then took over the search.

Trenny Gibson was wearing jeans, tennis shoes, a CPO jacket

and a sweater. She had no money or identification with her.

"Trenny hadn't planned on going on the field trip Friday morning," her mother said at the time of the search. "She thought it would be called off because of the rain and didn't even take a jacket with her."

She had borrowed a jacket from a friend after she found out the field trip was still on.

The Gibsons believed foul play was involved because their daughter was a top student, well-liked and did not date. They described her as a serious student and said they did not believe she would have run away with a boy or for any other reason.

She also had no money with her and had left a bank book, showing an account of \$1,000, at home.

The Gibson family said at the time of their daughter's disappearance that one year earlier the family had received threats from an unnamed person and said they feared that person had abducted their daughter.

Ted Bundy, who recently was electrocuted for the murder of several women, was questioned about the disappearance of Trenny Gibson but told FBI authorities he knew nothing about it, Bob Gibson said.

The area to be covered will include a two mile radius of the point where Miss Gibson was last seen on the Andrews Bald Trail, one-half mile south of Clingmans Dome. The line sweep method will be utilized in the immediate zone of probability and no air support will be necessary. All major trails and drainages in the area will also be searched.

Time interval for the search will be April 18 to approximately Saturday April 30, on a daily basis during daylight hours and as weather permits.

Plans and activities will be critiqued daily on site at the Dome Search Operations and Communications Center.

Mr. Gibson indicated that the Assistant Superintendent had told one of his investigators (Me McGahee?) that we would only search the area between Clingmans Dome and Andrews Bald, and only stay on the trails, using no more than 25 people - and those would be Rangers only.

I told Mr. Gibson that I was sure that his investigator had confused the information, as I know that Jerry is well aware of our intentions - which are not to limit the search in those ways.

Mr. Gibson said that if we would agree not to limit the search to 25 Rangers, he'd agree not to go to the papers. I told him that his going to the papers, or not going, had nothing to do with how many people we would use in the search; but that we would do everything we could to make sure that it was thorough, well organized, and well controlled, so that the best possible job could be done. I told him that, in any case, the contacts with communications media should be handled through this office, and low profile, to avoid any circus atmosphere. He wanted to know why we were starting after the weekend, and I told him that I was sure that it was because we wanted to avoid conflict with heavy backcountry use - and, again, to minimize any chance of a circus atmosphere.

I told him that we would use the search plan developed by our personnel, unless I felt that it was in some way inadequate; and that I am sure we plan to use more than just Park Rangers. He said he would like some searchers not ordinarily associated with the Park Service involved (implying a need for someone to be sure we are doing the job right), and I said that we would try to accommodate that.

I did not commit us to anything more than 25 people, nor to any period exceeding the April 18 through 30 period apparently already set.

Dick or Jack - please give me a trief written outline of your search plan, and of who will be involved, and when. I want to let Mr. Gibson know, early the week of the 11th.



Friday, October 8, 1976 at 1630 hours Park Technician Sammy Lail learned of a possible lost girl off of the Clingmans Dome Parking Area/Andrews Bald Trail. The girl is a Miss. Trenny Gibson of Knoxville, Tennessee. She was with a high school group led by Mr. Wayne Dunlap hiking to Andrews Bald.

Sammy Lail, upon checking with the group's leader (Mr. Dunlap) concerning what had already been accomplished up to 1700 hours by the high school group informed Sub-district Ranger Gene Phillips of the situation. Sammy Lail then proceeded to again search the Dome Parking Area and because of information given to him proceeded out the Appalachain Trail towards Double Springs Shelter looking for Miss. Gibson.

A call-up of National Park Service personnel was started. Jackson County, N.C. Rescue Squad was mobilized and a crew was sent to Clingmans Dome Parking Area to assist the Park Service Crew in the 1st night search. Weather at this time was strong winds and heavy rain with the temperature in the low 30's.

All possible trails leading from the Dome Parking Area were checked on the night of Oct. 6 and the morning of Oct. 9, 1976 by National Park Service and Jackson County Rescue Squad Negative results.

Therefore it was determined that a full scale search would begin at 0700 hours on Oct.9,1976 Rescue squads from both North Carolina and Tenessee were alerted to send personnel to the
