ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This proceeding arises under the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010 (“CFPA”), Section 1057 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010, 12 U.S.C. § 5567 and the applicable regulations. It is scheduled for a hearing on October 16-17, 2019, in Covington, Louisiana. Respondent moved to dismiss the complaint due to Complainant’s pending complaint in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana (No. 18-CV-729-SDD-RLB), involving substantially the same allegations as the present administrative proceeding. The CFPA and implementing regulations permit the Complainant to file such an action. *See* 12 U.S.C. § 5567(c)(4)(D)(i); 29 C.F.R. § 1985.114(a). Complainant does not oppose dismissal without prejudice.

Accordingly, the above-captioned matter is hereby **DISMISSED** without prejudice for lack of continued jurisdiction, and the hearing scheduled for October 16-17, 2019, is **CANCELED**.
