ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE

This matter arises under the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010, Section 1057 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010, 12 U.S.C. §5567; 29 C.F.R. Part 1985.

On 10/13/2023, the Parties filed their Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice. They “stipulated to the dismissal of all claims brought by any party in this action with prejudice, with each party to bear its own fees and costs.”
