DISMISSAL ORDER ON REMAND

This case arises under the whistleblower protection provision of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C.A. § 300j-9(i). The complaint was dismissed at the OALJ level after the parties signed a settlement agreement. As part of that settlement, the parties agreed to file a joint motion for dismissal after the Respondent complied with Section 1, labeled "Payments." The case was dismissed before that joint motion was filed. The ARB remanded the case, stating that it could not be dismissed until the material terms of Section 1 were fulfilled.

On July 28, 2010 the parties filed a Joint Motion for Dismissal with Prejudice. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
