ORDER

This proceeding arises from a complaint filed by George Skidmore against Transaction Systems Architects, Inc., under Section 806 of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act (SOX) of 2002 (18 U.S.C. § 1514A) and the regulations promulgated thereunder [29 C.F.R.
