FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arose out of a discrimination complaint filed under the whistleblower protection provision of Section 806 of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act. 18 U.S.C. § 1514A (2000). On December 19, 2007, the parties filed a Stipulation of Voluntary Dismissal, in which the parties requested that the Presiding Judge dismiss Complainant's complaint with prejudice, with each party bearing its own costs.

Accordingly, having reviewed the record in this case, and being otherwise fully advised of the premises of the parties' Stipulation of Voluntary Dismissal, it is hereby ORDERED that pursuant to 29 C.F.R. 1980.111(c), Complainant's objections to the OSHA determination are withdrawn and the case is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, each party to bear its own costs and fees.
