**DECISION AND ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO
WITHDRAW OBJECTIONS AND DISMISS PROCEEDING**

This proceeding arises from a complaint of discrimination filed under the employee protection provisions of Section 405 of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act ("STAA"), as amended, 49 U.S.C.A. § 31105 (West 2008) and the procedural regulations found at 29 C.F.R. Part 1978 (2012). On August 15, 2013, the Complainant filed a Motion To Withdraw Objections and Dismiss Proceeding. The motion withdraws Complainant's objections to the Secretary's Findings and moves the court to dismiss this proceeding. Based on the foregoing, I hereby GRANT the Complainant's Motion and it is ORDERED that the matter is dismissed and the hearing scheduled for August 23, 2013 is cancelled.
