**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL, CANCELING  
HEARING, AND DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

A hearing in the above-captioned matter is scheduled for June 20, 2014 in Atlanta, Georgia. A review of the file indicates that mail sent to the address provided for Complainant has been returned marked "wrong address, please return to sender," and that the person answering calls at the telephone number provided for Complainant has not seen him in two months and does not know how to reach him. Accordingly, I issued an order on February 6, 2014, directing counsel for Complainant to provide this Office with updated contact information for Complainant. Counsel responded with a notice of withdrawal as counsel, indicating that all certified mail sent to Complainant was returned and that Complainant could not be reached at the telephone number that counsel had for Complainant. Because Complainant is unreachable, it would be a waste of time and resources to proceed with the scheduled hearing given the likelihood that he will not appear. Should Complainant contact this Office and provide valid contact information, this matter may be reinstated subject to appropriate motions.

In light of the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Counsel's notice of withdrawal, herein deemed to be a motion for leave to withdraw as counsel for Complainant, is GRANTED;

2. The hearing scheduled for June 20, 2014 is CANCELED; and
3. The complaint in this matter is DISMISSED.
