ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This proceeding arises from a complaint filed under the Surface Transportation Assistance Act, 49 U.S.C. § 31105 (“STAA” or the “Act”), and the procedural regulations found at 29 C.F.R. Part 1978.

On February 2, 2022, Complainant filed a letter with the Court, advising that the parties settled this matter. After receipt of this letter, my office made attempts to set up a call with the parties to discuss the filing of settlement documents. I scheduled a telephonic conference call for May 4, 2022.

On May 4, 2022, I sent an email order to the parties, cancelling the telephonic conference call and advising the parties that I interpreted Complainant’s February 2, 2022, letter to be a withdrawal of the complaint pursuant to 29 C.F.R. 1978.111(c).

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Complainant’s request to withdraw his case is **GRANTED**; and
2. The present claim before the Office of Administrative Law Judges is hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
