**ORDER APPROVING COMPLAINANT'S  
REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL  
AND CANCELLING HEARING**

This proceeding arises because of whistleblower complaints filed by Complainant against Respondent under the employee protection provisions of Section 7001(a) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (SWDA), 42 U.S.C. 6971; Section 507(a) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (FWPCA), 33 U.S.C. 1367; and, Section 23(a) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C. 2622, and the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. 300j-9. In brief, Complainant alleges that Respondent discharged him on or about March 4, 2008 in violations of these Acts.

On January 23, 2009, Counsel for Complainant filed with this Court a Request to Withdraw Complaint with a copy of a letter notarized by Complainant authorizing this withdrawal.

Having considered the foregoing, the Request to Withdraw Complaint is hereby **Granted** and the formal hearing scheduled for **April 27 – 28, 2009** in **Atlanta, Georgia** is hereby **Cancelled**.
