ORDER APPROVING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL AND CANCELLING HEARING

This proceeding arises because of whistleblower complaints filed by Complainant against Respondent under the employee protection provisions of Section 7001(a) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (SWDA), 42. U.S.C. 6971; Section 507(a) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (FWPCA), 33 U.S.C. 1367; and, Section 23(a) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C. 2622, and the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. 300j-9. In brief, Complainant alleges that Respondent discharged him on or about March 4, 2008 in violations of these Acts.

On January 23, 2009, Counsel for Complainant filed with this Court a Request to Withdraw Complaint with a copy of a letter notarized by Complainant authorizing this withdrawal.

Having considered the foregoing, the Request to Withdraw Complaint is hereby **Granted** and the formal hearing scheduled for **April 27 – 28, 2009** in **Atlanta, Georgia** is hereby **Cancelled**.
