ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case arises under the temporary agricultural labor provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 (Act), 8 U.S.C.A. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a) and §1184(c)(1), as amended, and its implementing regulations found at 20 CFR Part 655, Subpart B.

In this case the Certifying Office (CO) issued a "Notice of Deficiency" on February 6, 2012. Rather than responding to the "Notice of Deficiency" the Employer's counsel filed an appeal and a request for an administrative review on February 15, 2012.

On March 1, 2012 the Parties filed a "Joint Stipulation of Dismissal" in this case. The Parties stipulated that:

1. The Certifying Officer for the U.S. Department of Labor and the named petitioners have settled Cases Nos.2012-TLC-48, 2012-TLC-51, 2012-TLC-52, 2012-TLC-53, 2012-TLC-54, and 2012-TLC-55.
 2. All issues raised by these cases have been resolved and the applications in question containing the text agreed by the parties will be accepted for processing.
- The Parties request that the referenced cases be dismissed with prejudice.

In view of all the foregoing, the request for hearing is **DISMISSED**.
