ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case arises under the temporary agricultural labor provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 (Act), 8 U.S.C.A. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a) and § 1184(c)(1), as amended, and its implementing regulations found at 20 CFR Part 655, Subpart B.

The Employer's application was denied by the Certifying Office (CO) on February 15, 2012. Employer's counsel filed an appeal of the "Notice of Denial" and a request for a *de novo* review on February 22, 2012.

On March 1, 2012 the Parties filed a "Joint Stipulation of Dismissal" in this case. The Parties stipulated that:

1. The Certifying Officer for the U.S. Department of Labor and the named petitioners have settled Cases Nos. 2012-TLC-48, 2012-TLC-51, 2012-TLC-52, 2012-TLC-53, 2012-TLC-54, and 2012-TLC-55.
2. All issues raised by these cases have been resolved and the applications in question containing the text agreed by the parties will be accepted for processing.

The Parties request that the referenced cases be dismissed with prejudice. In view of all the foregoing, the request for hearing is **DISMISSED**.
