**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On June 18, 2012, Smith's Farm, Inc. ("Employer") filed a request for administrative review in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter, in response to receiving a Notice of Deficiency ("NOD") from the Certifying Officer ("CO"). On June 22, 2012, the Office of Administrative Law Judges received notice from Employer that it had corrected the deficiencies in its application that led to the Certifying Officer issuing a Notice of Deficiency. On June 25, 2012, counsel for the Certifying Officer ("CO") affirmed that Employer had submitted a corrected application that was accepted for processing. Therefore, Employer's request for *de novo* review of the CO's NOD is now moot. Accordingly, the matter is **DISMISSED** and returned to the CO for processing.
