ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 31, 2012, this Office received notice that the parties stipulated that the above-referenced proceeding should be dismissed with prejudice, on the following grounds:

- 1. The Certifying Officer for the U.S. Department of Labor and the Employer have settled Case Number 2012-TLC-00072.
- 2. All issues raised by this case have been resolved.
- 3. Employer shall file a modified Application with a job order that includes only the following worksites: Arrow Ridge, DNR Ice Harbor, Growers Ice Harbor, Dry Ice Harbor, Juniper Vista Orchard, Management Ice Harbor, Monkey Ridge, and Smith Orchard. With this change, the modified Application will be accepted for processing.
- 4. Concurrently with the modified Application, Employer will submit a separate Application that will be identical to the modified Application except for information relating to worksites. The worksites in the new Application will be as follows: ATM George, Babcock #3, Babcock North, Champs, Chief Bob, Dippy

Ridge, DNR Mattawa, DNR Neighbor, Hwy 28 Orchard, LLC, KTW, Little Brook, Little Lady Bug, Mattawa Road I, Newton, Purple Sage, Raven Orchard, Royal Flush Orchard, Royal M, Royal Orchard, Saddle Mountain West, SAM Cherries, and Son of SAM. The separate Application will be accepted for processing.

5. The delineation of areas of intended employment set forth herein shall not be precedential with respect to any other Application filed by Stemilt Ag Services, LLC.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **DISMISSED**.
