On September 14, 2010, a United States Department of Labor Administrative Law Judge issued a Decision and Order Dismissing Complaint in this case arising under the Federal Rail Safety Act (FRSA).<sup>1</sup> The Secretary of Labor has delegated her authority to issue final decisions for the Department of Labor under the FRSA to the Administrative Review Board.<sup>2</sup>
