ORDER OF CASE CLOSING

On June 13, 2013, the Complainant, B.C. Woodham, filed a Petition for Review in this case arising under the employee protection provisions of the Federal Railway Safety Act of 1982 (FRSA).¹ The FRSA's implementing regulations provide:

> If a timely petition for review is filed pursuant to paragraph (a) of this section, the decision of the ALJ will become the final order of the Secretary unless the ARB, within 30 days of the filing of the petition, issues an order notifying the parties that the case has been accepted for review.^[2]
