**ORDER GRANTING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL**

The Administrative Review Board received a petition for review on September 16, 2016, from Complainant/Prosecuting Party Alexia Palmer requesting the Board to review a Department of Labor Administrative Law Judge's Decision and Order Denying Request for Hearing Due to Lack of Jurisdiction in this case arising under the H-1B provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended.<sup>1</sup> The Board gave notice of its intent to review the Administrative
