**ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR INTERLOCUTORY REVIEW**

Complainant Randall Pittman has filed a petition for interlocutory review of an Administrative Law Judge's Order Denying Motion to Disqualify in this case arising under the whistleblower protection provisions of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act.<sup>1</sup> The Secretary of Labor has delegated authority to the Administrative Review Board to review interlocutory rulings in exceptional circumstances arising in SOX cases.<sup>2</sup> Pittman has

failed to allege exceptional circumstances sufficient to merit interlocutory review in this case.
