David has served at different times as General Counsel of Asia, Middle East & Africa, Latin America and Frito-Lay North America, and has led the legal aspects of many of the company's significant M&A projects.

He is also an active member of the New York State Council of Business Leaders in Support of Access to Justice, the Association of General Counsel and the World Economic Forum's Global Future Council on Transparency and Anti-Corruption.

David spent the first 10 years of his career with one of Australia's leading law firms, Corrs Chambers Westgarth, and was a corporate and anti-trust partner based in Melbourne. Prior to joining PepsiCo, David was the General Counsel for Asia Pacific and Middle East with Danone S.A. He has lived in Australia, New Zealand, China and Dubai and is now based in Purchase, NY.
