# Teen Scene Information

## 1. You must be a registered member to join in Teen Scene Social Club activities.

To join, individuals must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Resides in Prince George's County, and has an intellectual or developmental disability.
- Meet the age requirements of the club (13 – 21).
- Able to stay with the group, follow directions and participate in large community settings with a staff/participant ratio of 1:4 (i.e., sporting events, museum trips, community festivals, movies, daytrips).
- Able to stay with the group in a large setting.
- Able to perform daily life skills (i.e., dressing, eating, toileting, mobility, etc.) with minimal staff support.
- Able to communicate basic needs and identification (i.e., name and phone number), either verbally or by showing an ID card or bracelet.
- Complete the registration form and pay the \$55 membership fee via PARKS DIRECT.
- Able to administer your own medication. Staff can distribute only with a signed Medication Form
- Be able to engage in scheduled activities for the majority of the program (with or without an accommodation).

## 2. All interested teens must complete and submit a Registration Form and complete an intake, prior to joining the club.

3. Once a member, a monthly newsletter will be mailed to you with the scheduled activities. Participants must sign up for each activity via the **PARKS DIRECT system ([www.pgparksdirect.com](http://www.pgparksdirect.com), or call 301-446-3400)** and will require any activity fees to be paid at the time of your reservation. Many of the activities have limited spaces available and are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. **Trips without a minimum of 4 registrations are subject to cancellation.**

4. If you have made a reservation and your plans change, please call the Special Programs Division Office, by the "Reservation deadline", to cancel your reservation so we can accommodate those who may be on the waiting list. In the event you do not show three or more times, your social club membership could be cancelled for the remainder of the year.

5. A **late fee of \$10.00** for every 15 minutes (or portion, thereof) will be assessed to individuals not picked up by the activity's/program's pick-up time. Continued lateness could result in cancellation of your social club membership.

6. If a **Storm Warning or Weather Advisory** has been issued two hours before an activity/event, **the activity will be cancelled.** Participants will be contacted regarding program cancellations. 7. All outdoor activities will have a back-up activity in case of rain, such as a movie, bowling or museum. Meeting times and locations will remain the same.
