FINAL ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Commissioner, having reviewed and considered the pleadings and record on file in the above-styled proceeding, now finds and concludes that the Enforcement Section has prevailed on the claims in its petition and further makes findings of fact and conclusions of law and enters a final order as follows:

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

- 1. On December 29, 2004, the enforcement section submitted a Petition for Administrative Relief to the Commissioner of Securities in the above matter.
- On January 5, 2005, the Commissioner of Securities issued a Summary Order to Cease and Desist.
- 3. On January 6, 2005, Notice of the Summary Action was sent to Hasho at his last known address on file with the Commissioner. This Notice was returned to the Division by the U.S. Postal Service on January 14, 2005, marked "Refused".
- 4. On January 14, 2005, a Notice of Service of Process was served upon the Commissioner. A copy of this Notice was sent to Respondent at his last known address. This Notice was returned to the Division by the U.S. Postal Service on February 8, 2005, and marked "Unclaimed".
- Respondent did not request a hearing.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Order of January 5, 2005, are incorporated herein and these Finding and Conclusions and Order are FINAL as to this Respondent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent is BARRED from registering in the State of Missouri.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in this proceeding. This amount shall be made payable to the State of Missouri, and the Secretary of State shall forward these funds to the state treasury for the benefit of county and township school funds as provided in Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of Missouri. If Respondents miss any payment, the full amount remaining shall be immediately due and payable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent shall pay the costs of investigation in the amount of one thousand seven hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$1,775). This amount shall be payable to the Missouri Secretary of State's Investor Education and Protection Fund.
