→ Preparatory [ministerial-level meeting](#) for the 2024 African Counter-Terrorism Summit on the margins of UNGA78 (21 Sep)



→ Tenth [GCTF - Compact Partnership Consultation](#) (12 Oct)



→ UN Security Council CTC [open meeting](#) on countering terrorist narratives (19 Oct)



→ ICAO [Security Week 2023](#) focused on [aviation security](#) & featured a [side event](#) on the link between counter-terrorism and aviation security (23-27 Oct)



→ [Fourth FAFT Plenary](#) discussed money laundering, terrorism financing and proliferation financing issues (25-27 Oct)



ENGAGEMENT WITH MEMBER STATES

→ UNOCT held its [second quarterly briefing](#) to Member States on its activities, including the work of the Counter-Terrorism Compact (7 Sep)



→ GCTF held its [13th Ministerial and 22nd Coordinating Committee](#) meetings and four side events, including the [launch of the BSM Initiative](#) (18-21 Sep)

→ [Fourth Ministerial meeting](#) of the Group of Friends of Victims of Terrorism supported the rights and needs of victims of terrorism (20 Sep)



→ [Albania](#) and [Zimbabwe](#) became the 121st and 122nd State parties to ICSANT (20 Sep and 28 Oct)

KEY ISSUES RAISED BY HEADS OF ENTITIES

→ [CTED ASG Gherman](#) warned that the threat of terrorism in Africa has evolved in its scope, operational manifestation, and resilience (7 Sep)

→ [UNODC USG Waly](#) [highlighted](#) development of innovative toolkits tailored for legal and technical practitioners, as well as trainings for new generations of judges and prosecutors on ICSANT (18 Sep)

→ [SG Guterres](#) [reiterated](#) that hate speech, disinformation and conspiracy theories on social media platforms are spreading and amplified by AI, undermining democracy and fueling violence and conflict in real life (19 Sep)

→ [UNOCT USG Voronkov](#) [highlighted](#) the strategies, tools, and resources to fight terrorism, including the GCTS and the SG's policy brief on A New Agenda for Peace (21 Sep)

→ [UNICRI Director De Meo](#) [stressed](#) the security implications of organized criminal networks and armed and terrorist groups involved in looting, smuggling and trafficking cultural heritage to finance criminal and terrorist enterprises (29 Sep)

→ [UNOSAPG USG Nderitu](#) [discussed](#) the 'key, but often overlooked challenge in post-genocide societies and beyond' at the Nuremberg Forum (19 Oct)



→ UNODC supported Zambia (18-19 Sep) and Botswana (21-22 Sep) to [prevent the proliferation of WMD](#) by non-state actors through implementation of UNSCR 1540

→ UNOCT signed MoUs with [ECOWAS](#) (22 Sep) and [University of Málaga](#) (27 Sep)



→ UNODC rolled-out technical assistance activities for Nigerian police and Joint Investigation Centre on human rights, community policing and forensic recovery (Sep-Oct)

→ USG Nderitu conducted a high-level mission to Chad (25-27 Oct)

→ [Nigeria](#) became the third Member State to complete the UN Programme on Threat Assessment Models for Aviation Security (TAM Programme) (30 Oct)

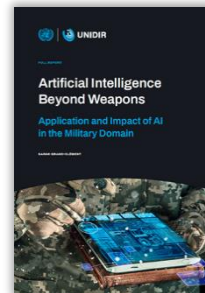

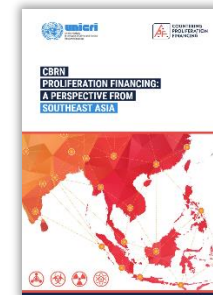

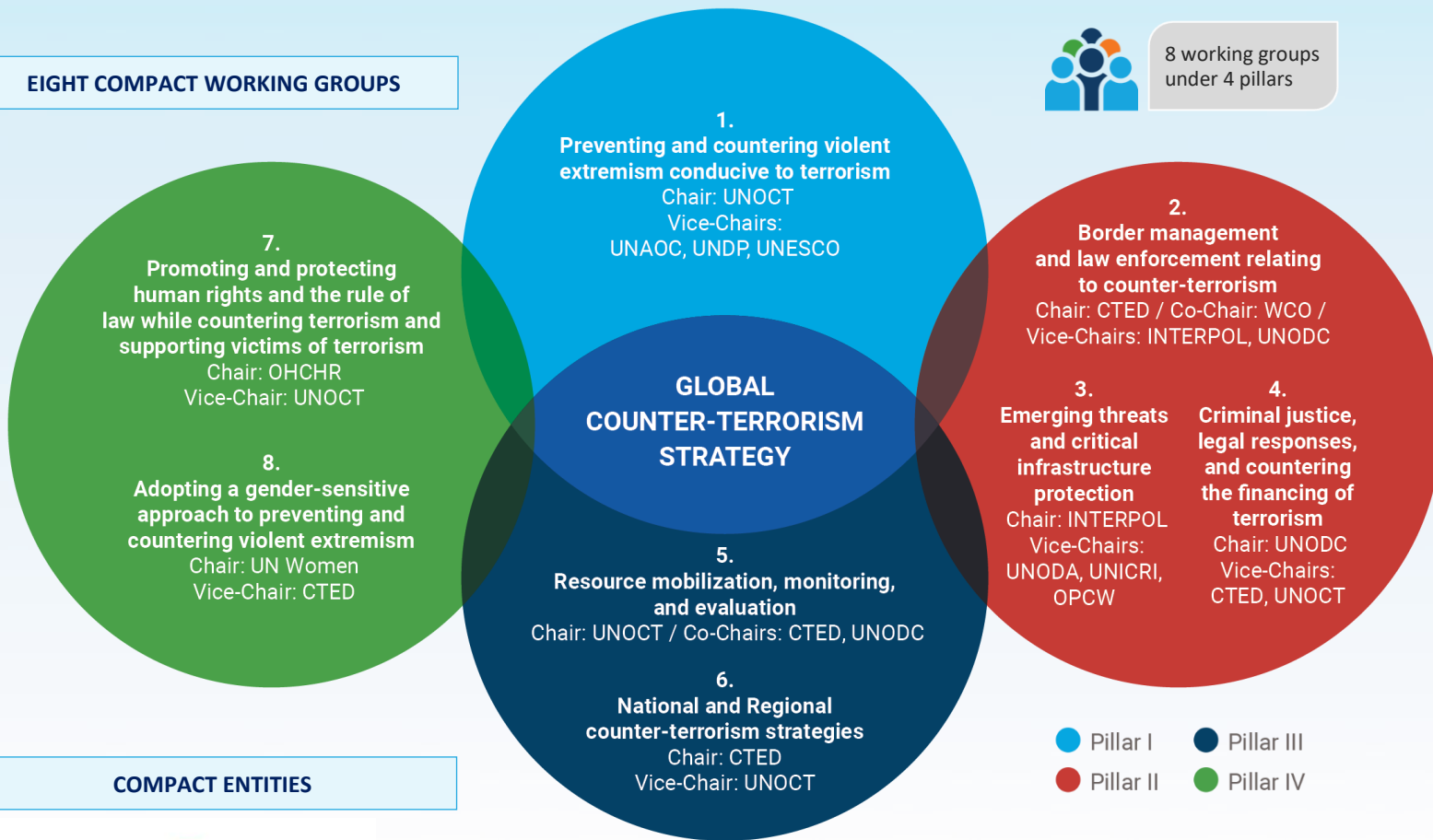
