- Central African Republic;
- The Situation in Mali;
- Activities of the United Nations Office for West Africa and the Sahel;
- United Nations Verification Mission in Colombia;
- Situation in South Sudan;
- United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo;
- The situation in Central Africa and the activities of the United Nations Regional Office for Central Africa;
- Joint Force of the Group of Five for the Sahel;
- Implementation of the Peace, Security and Cooperation Framework for the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the Region;

- Promotion of durable peace and sustainable development in Africa;
